The "Sant Maral" foundation presents the results of the October-November 2006 survey. The representative sample of 1775 respondents from the capital Ulan Bator and Hovd, Dornogovi, Dornod, Bayanhongor aymaks was collected from October 27 to November 3, 2006. Tabulations are band by Capital, Countryside and Nationwide areas.


