The "Sant Maral" foundation presents the results of the November 2005 survey. The representative sample of 1738 respondents from the capital Ulan Bator and Suhbaatar, Tuv, Uvurhangay, Zavhan aymaks was collected from 7 to 14 of November, 2005. Tabulations are band by Rural, Capital and Nationwide areas. The survey is sponsored by the Konrad Adenauer Foundation of Germany.


