

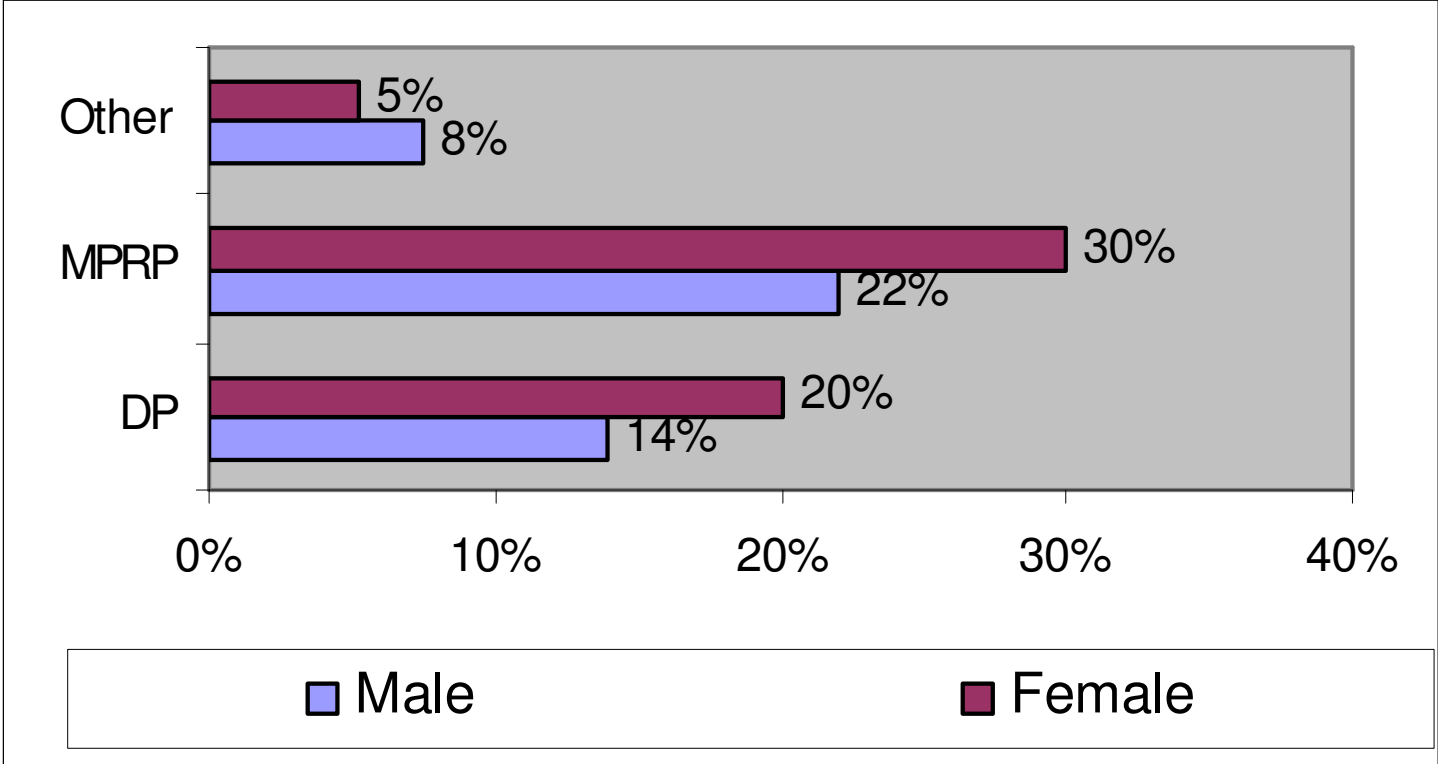
**INTERNAL DEMOCRACY WITHIN MONGOLIAN

Survey result

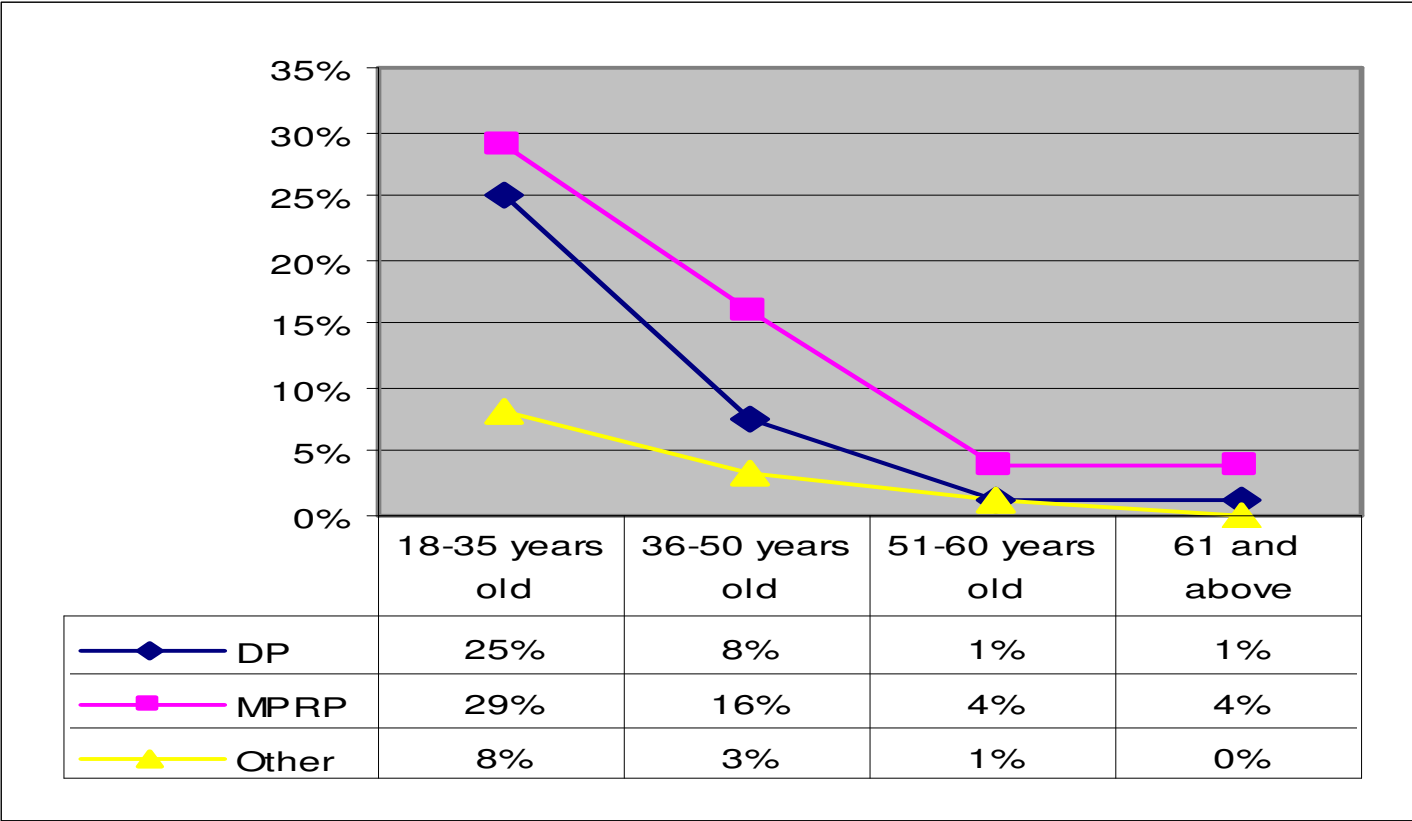

- 4 aimags and Ulaanbaatar were randomly selected members and activists, head of party in this survey. A totally 500 members of party were responded, but only 348 members of party were calculated in the survey.

 - MDNSP Mongolian Democratic New Socialist Party

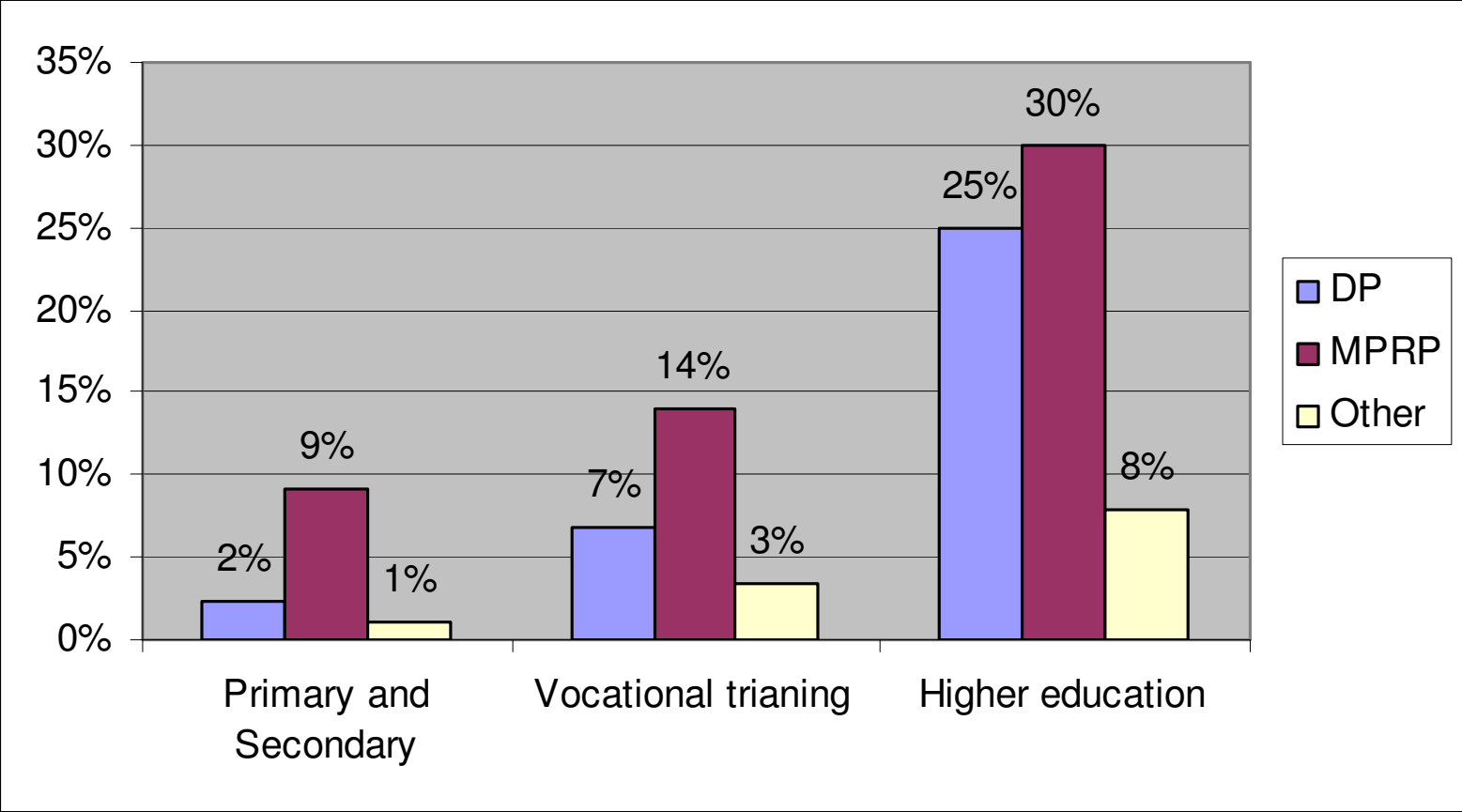

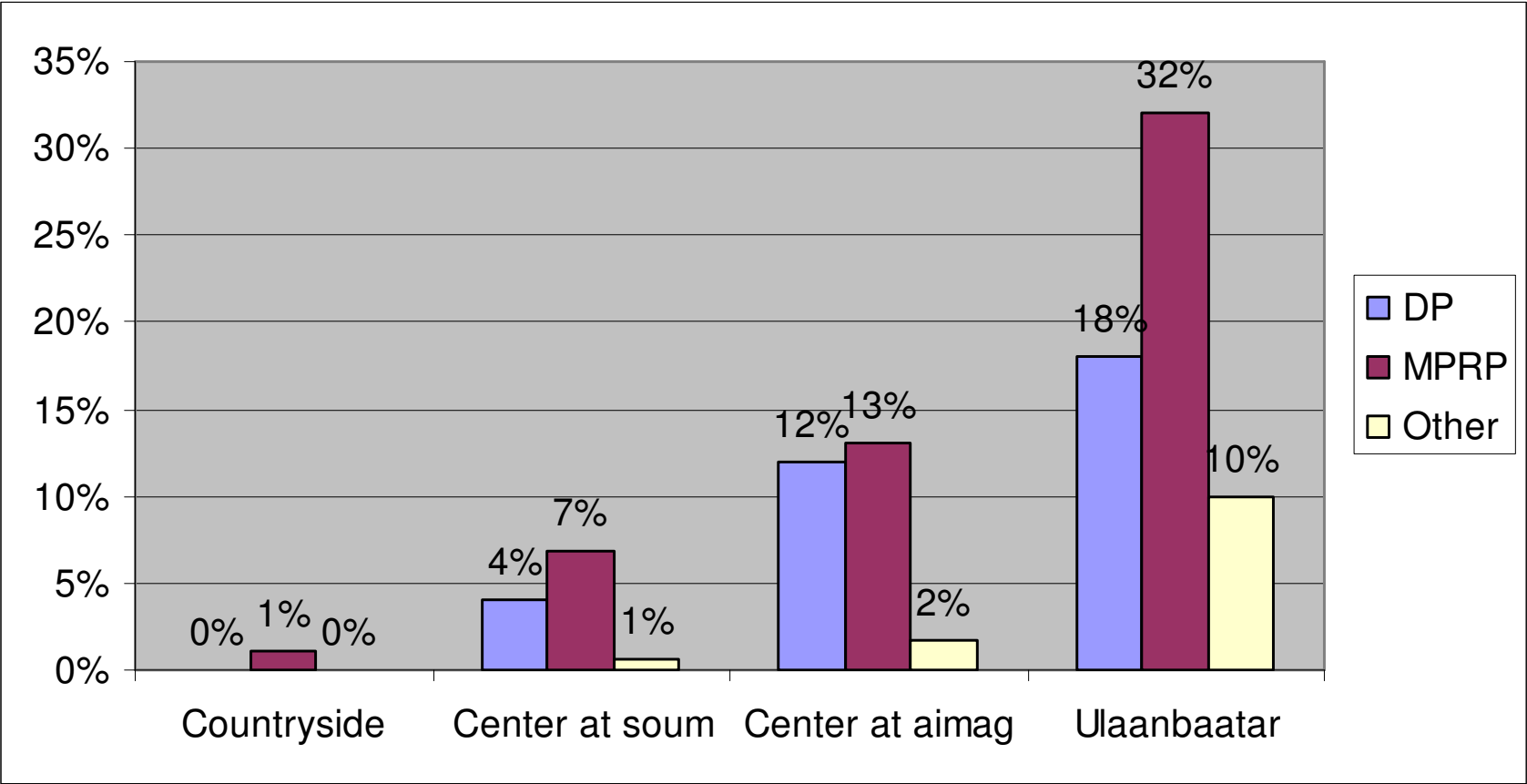
Question-2 Age



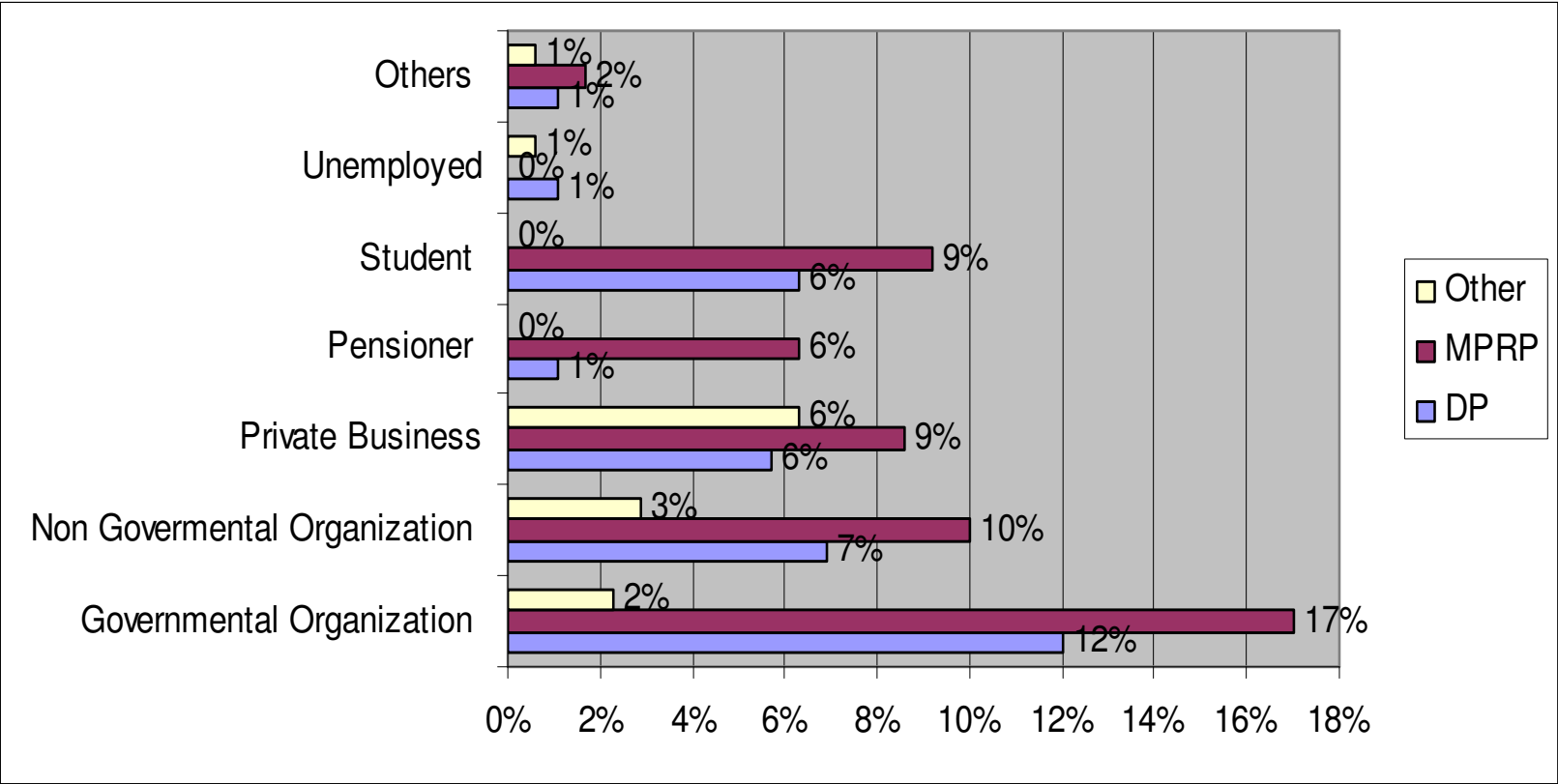
Question-3 Education level



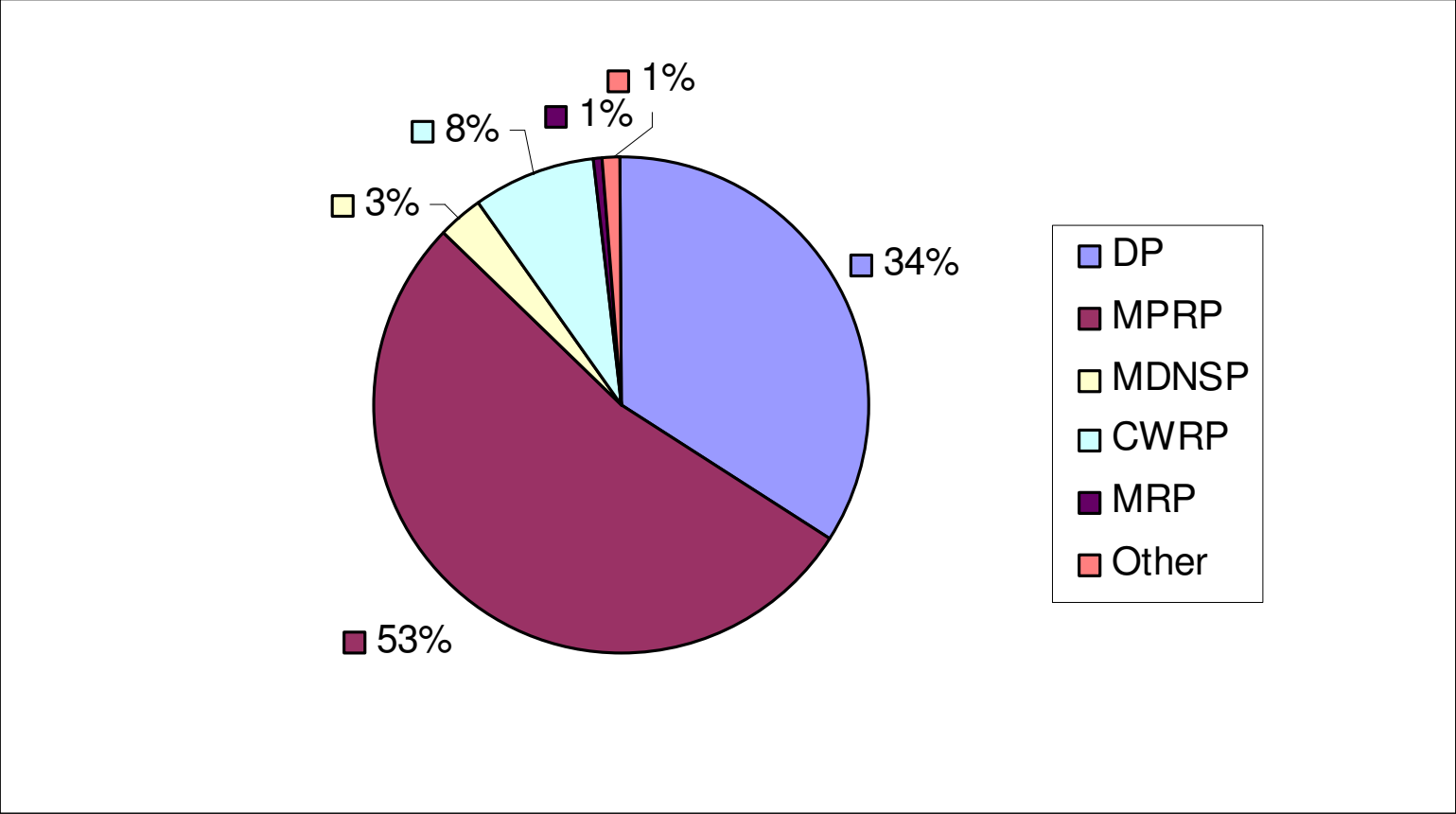

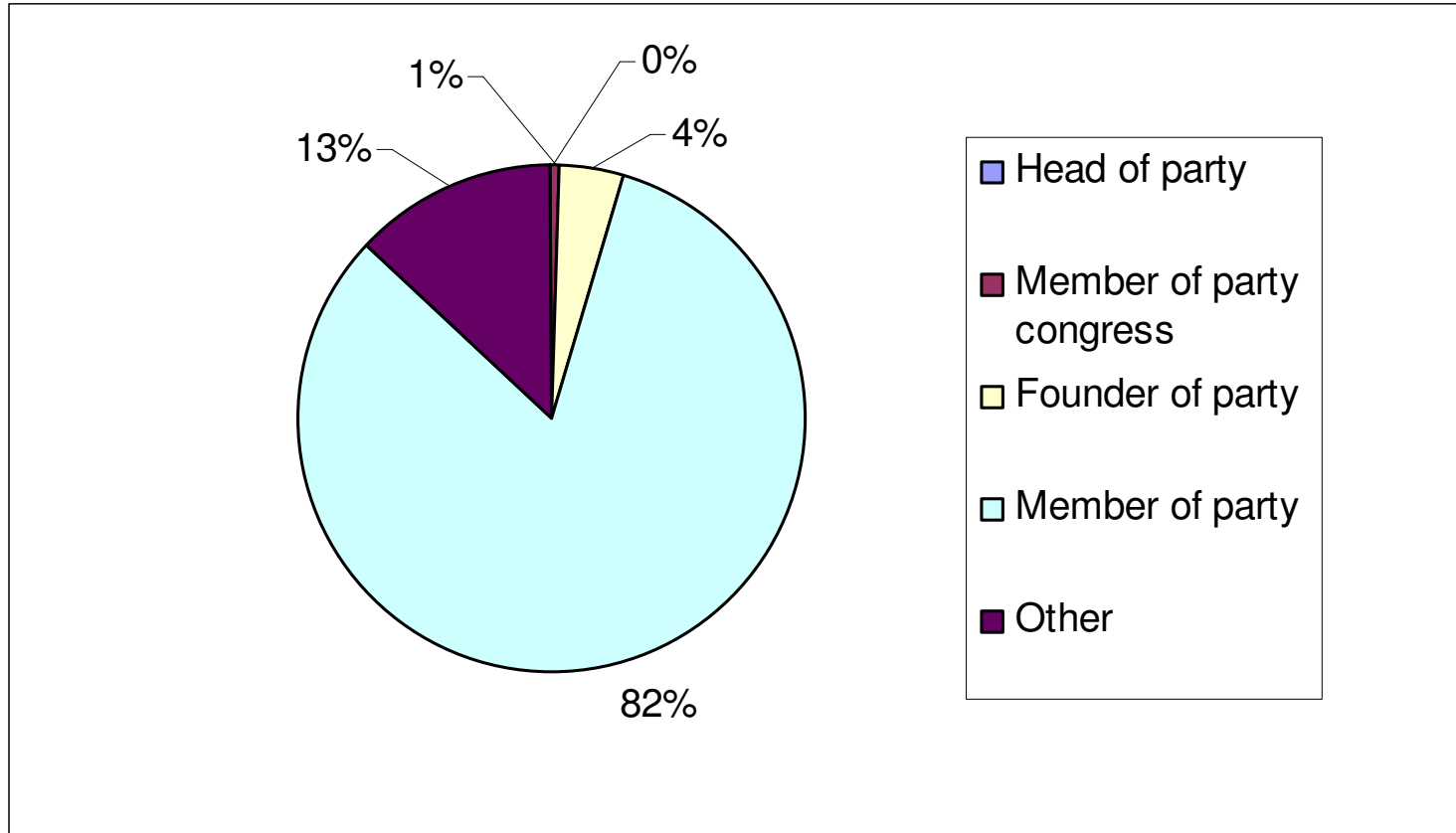

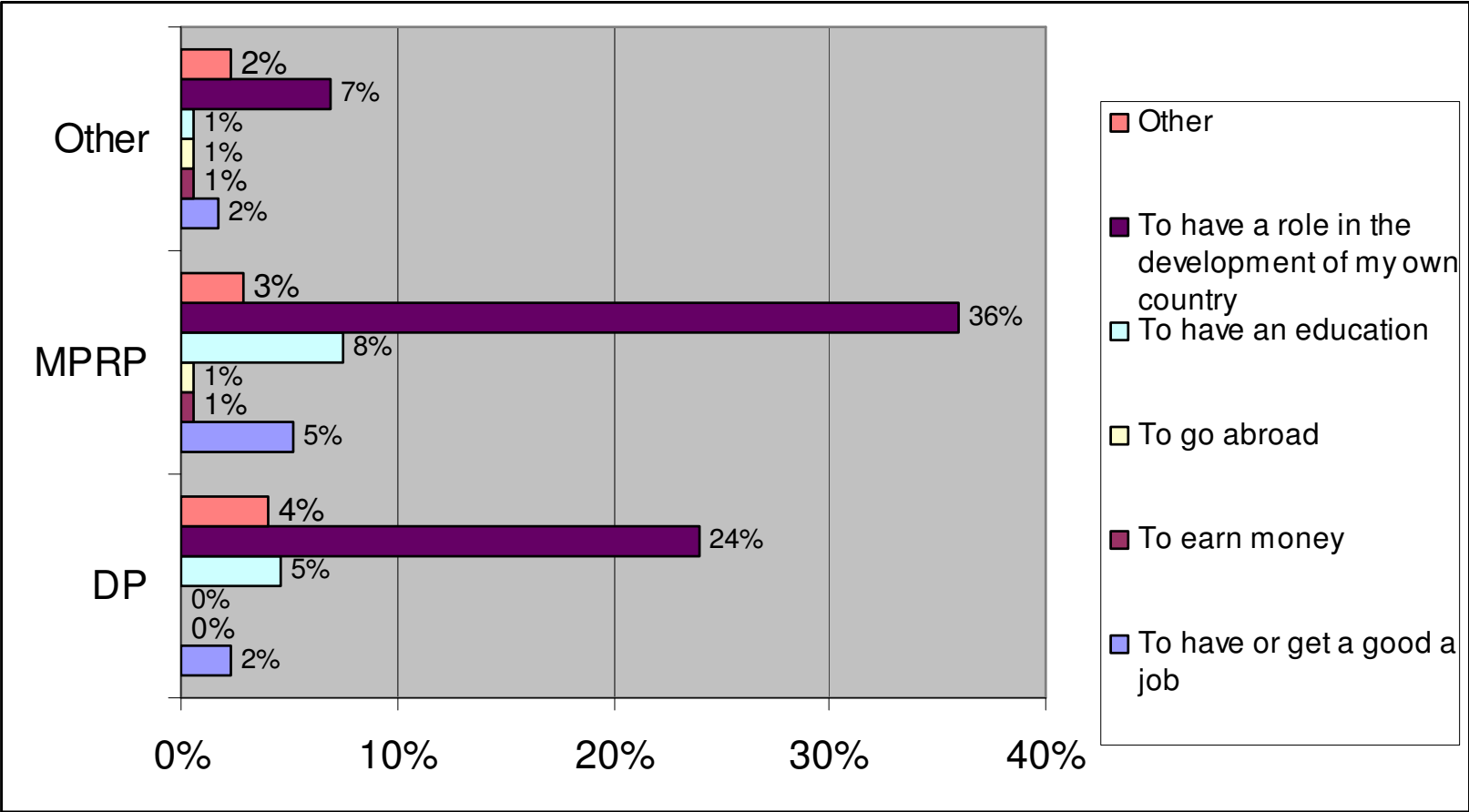

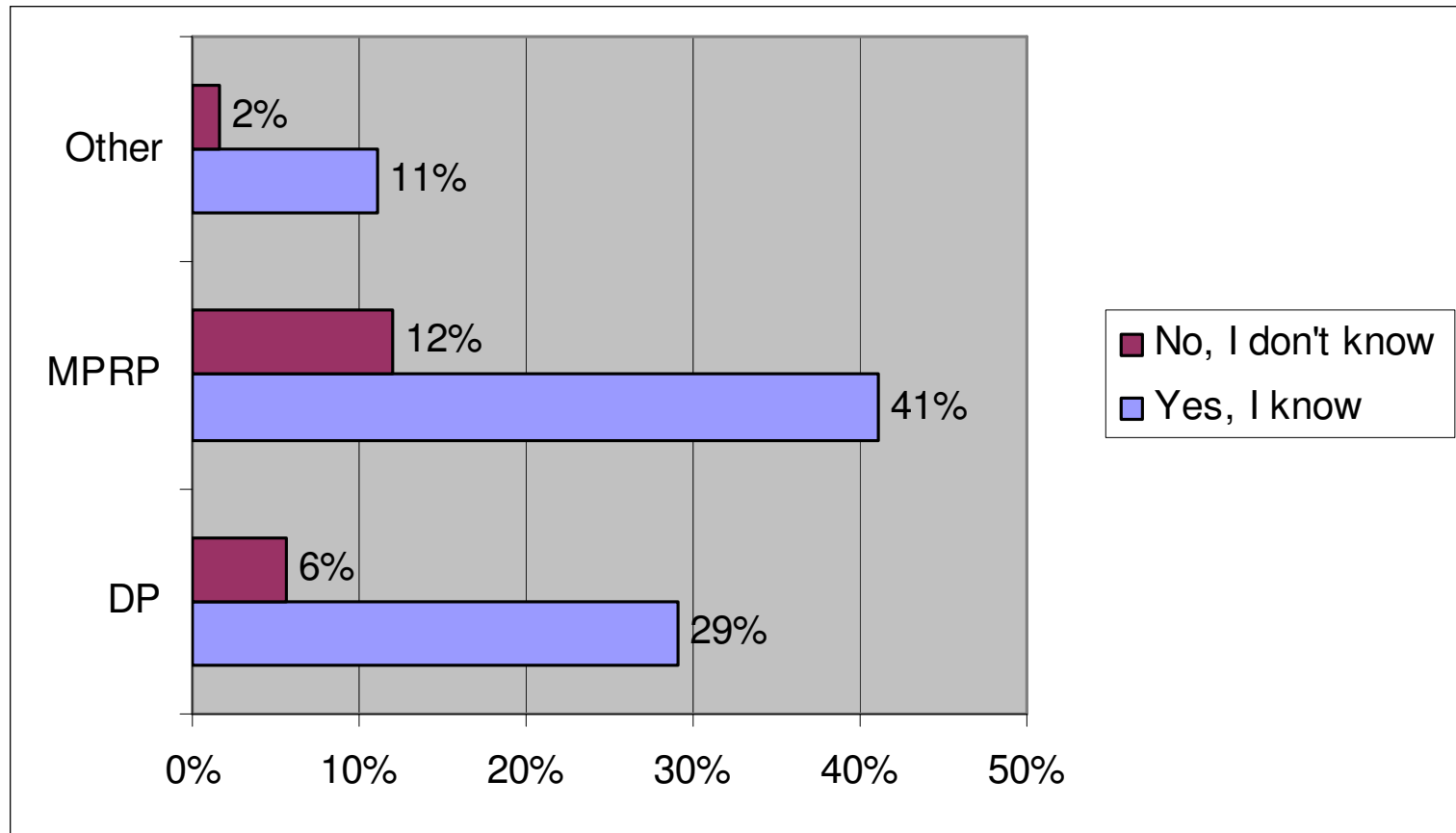

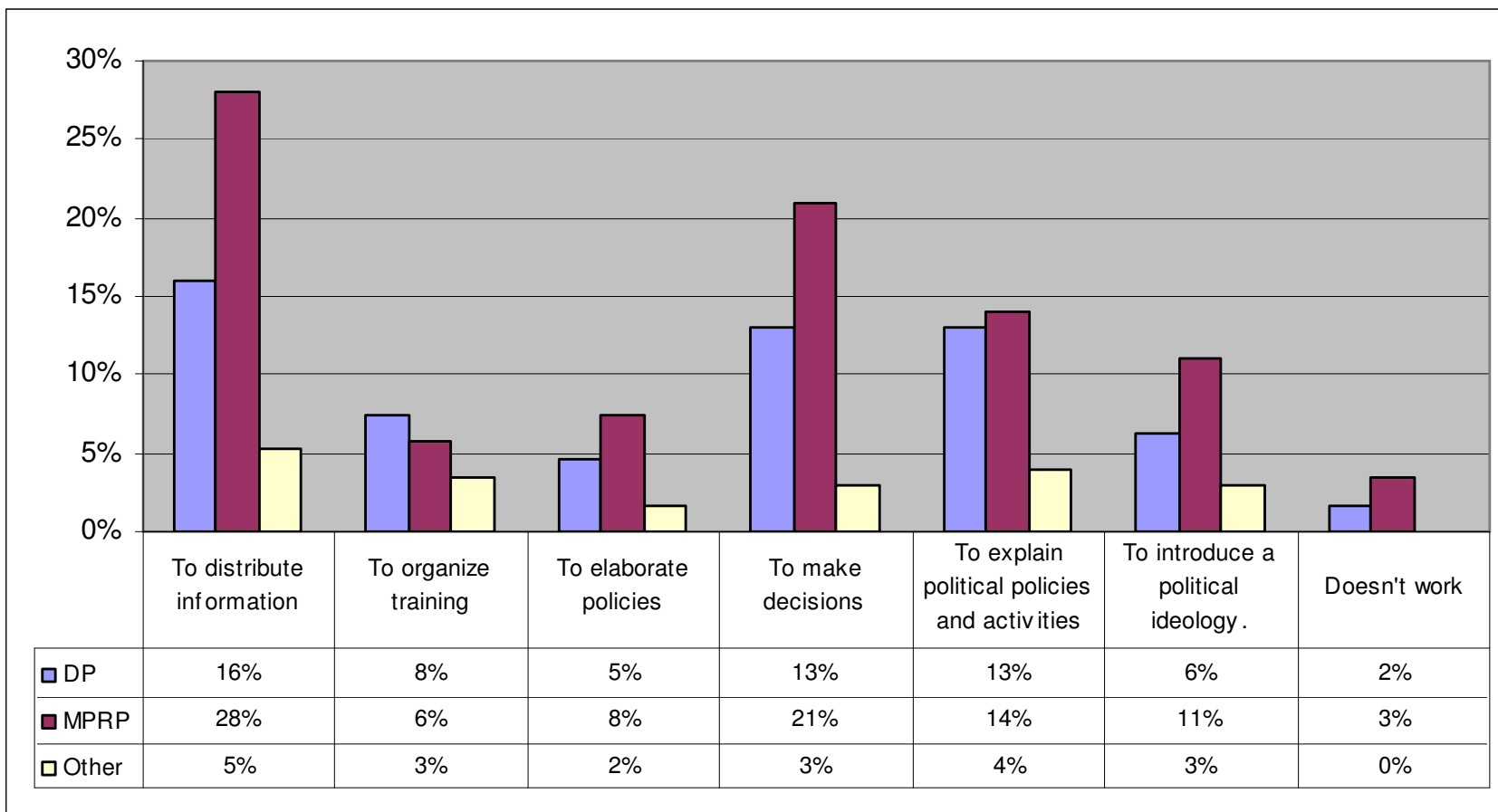

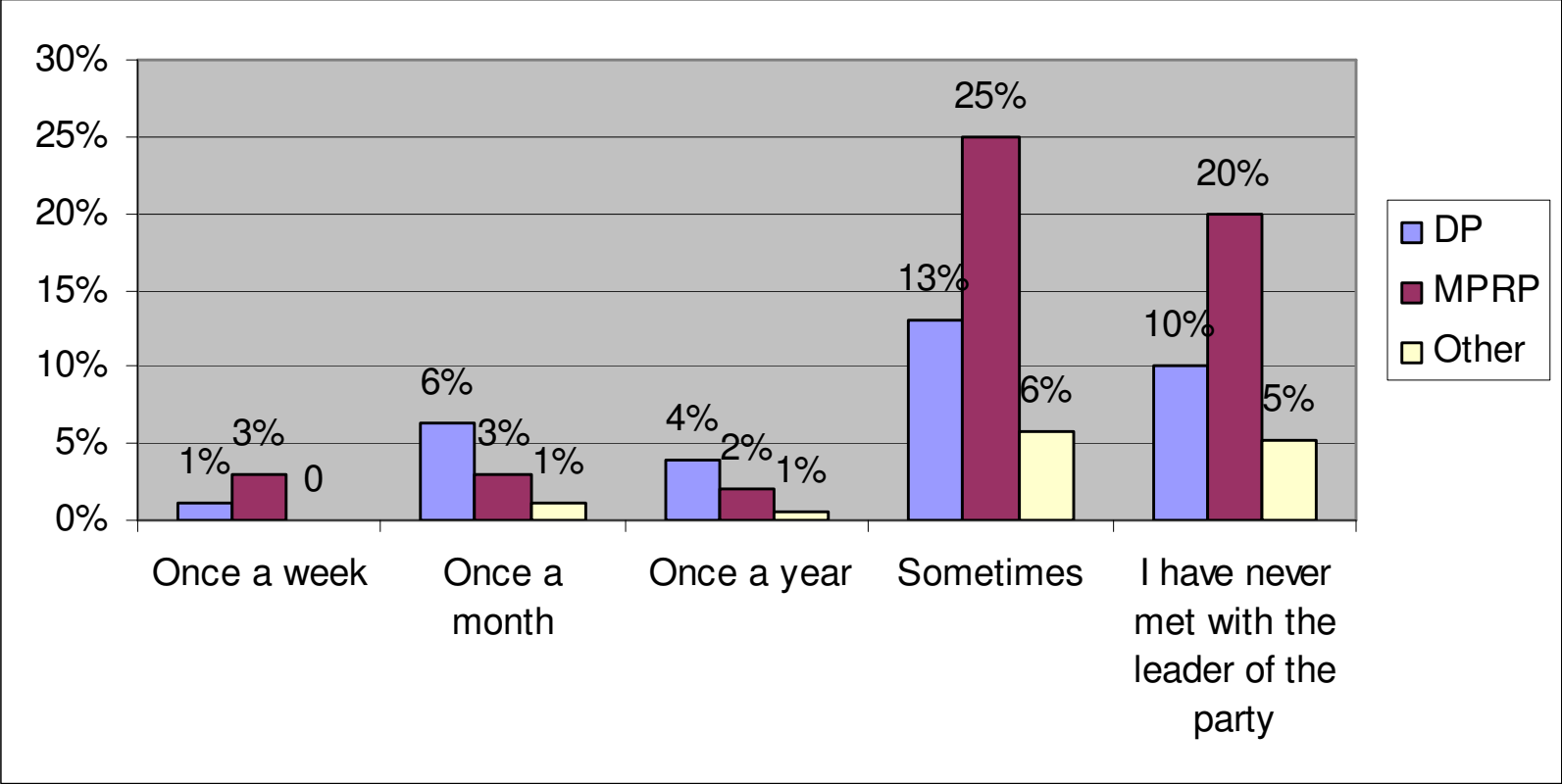

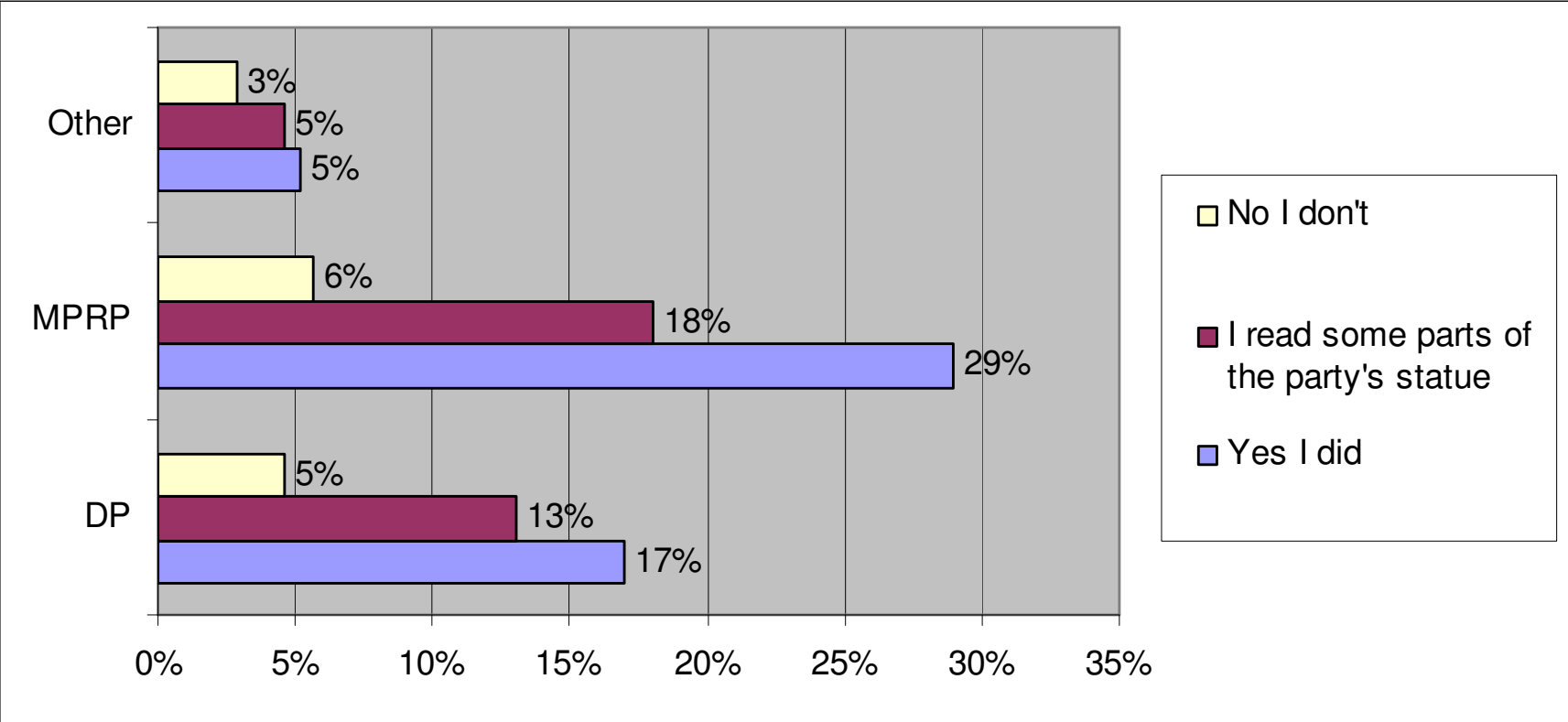

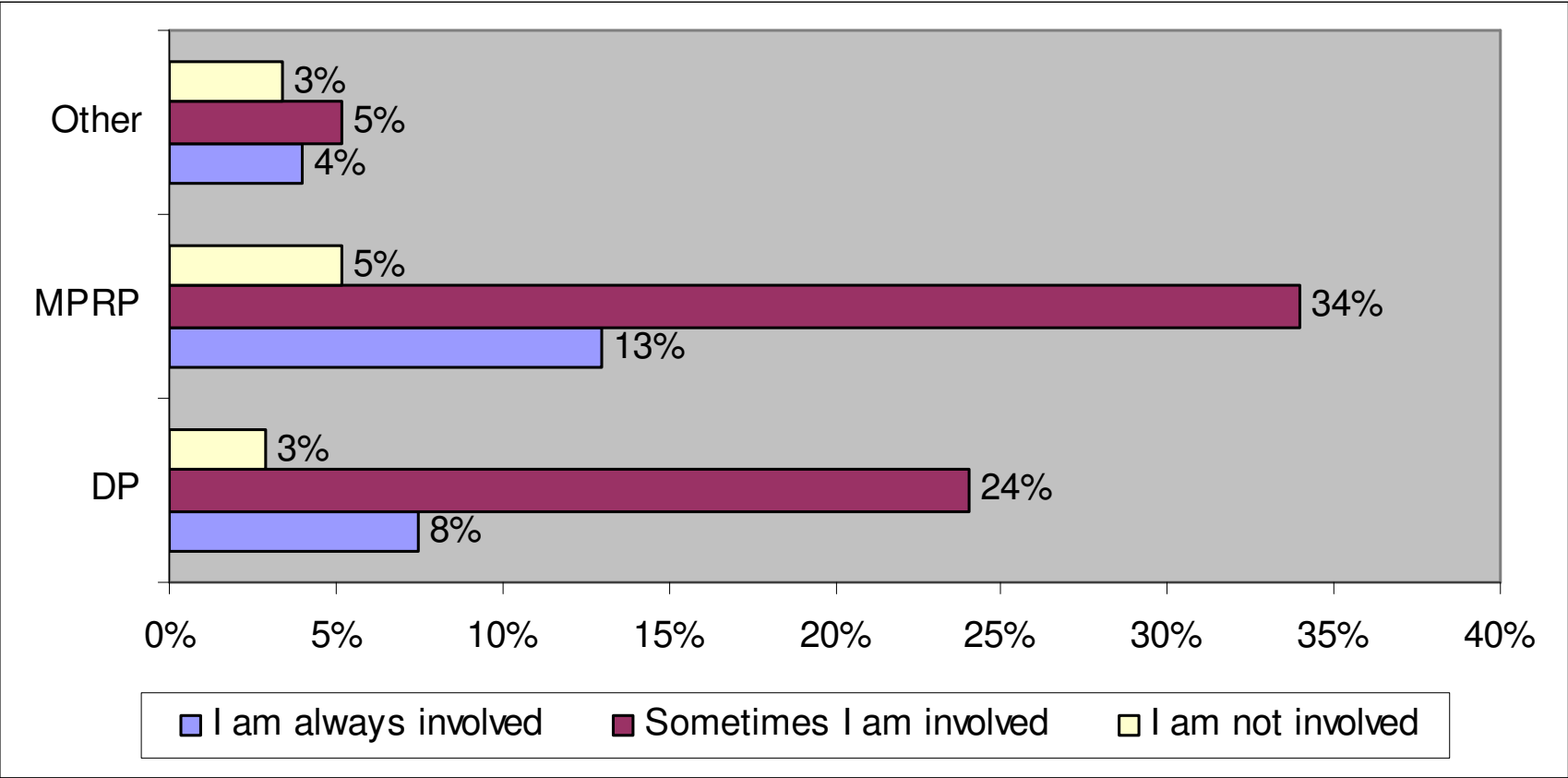

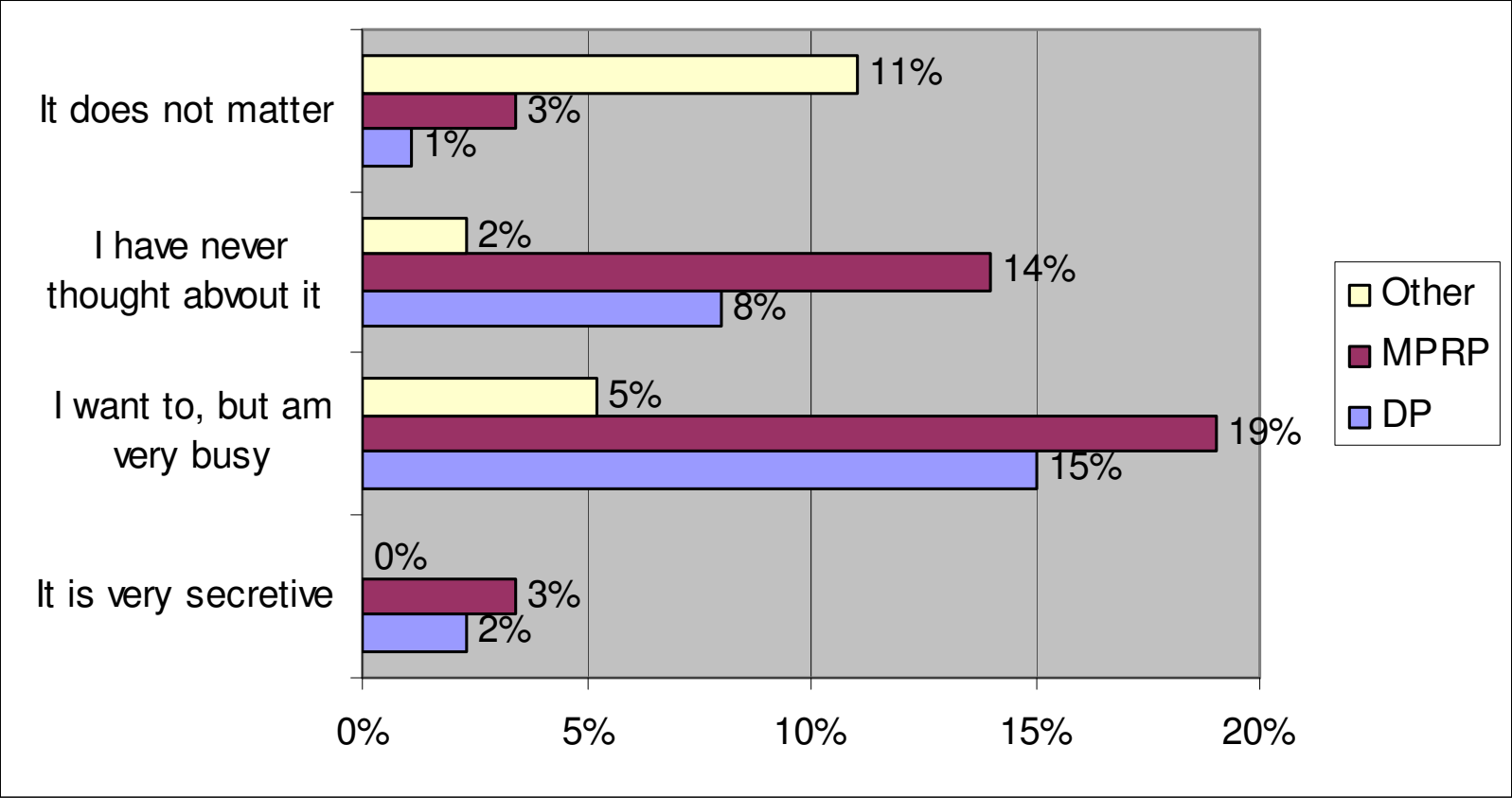

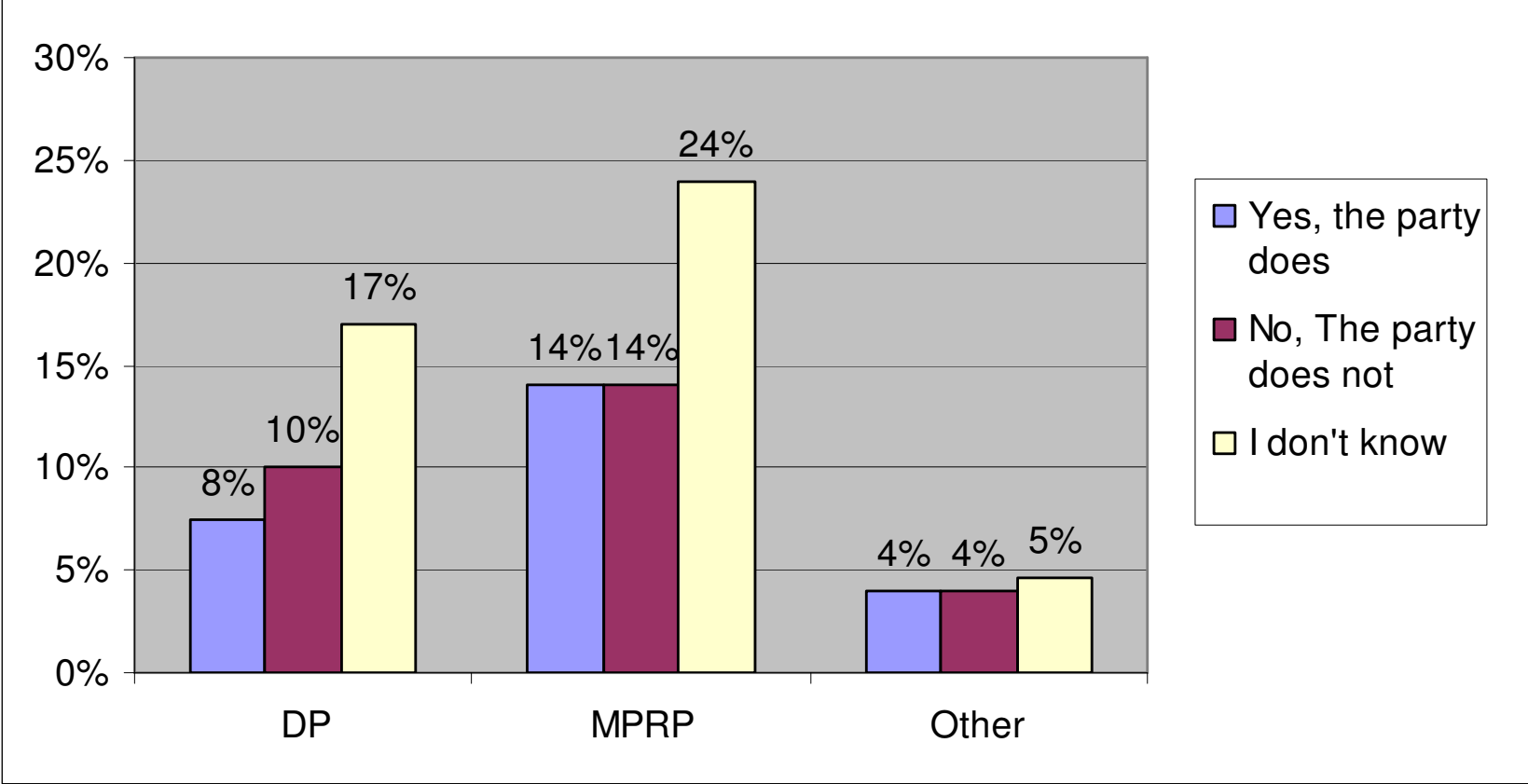

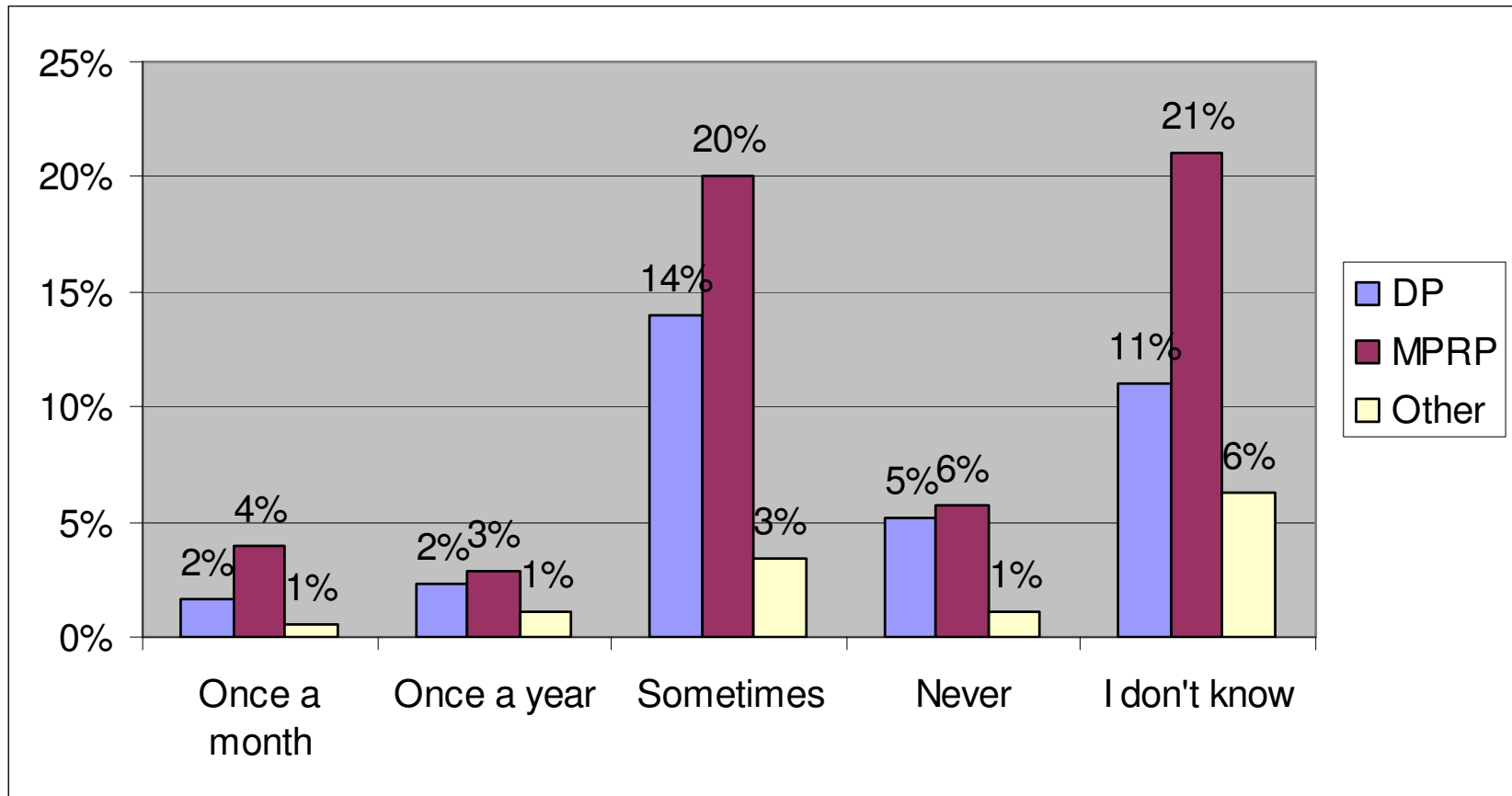
Question-14. If you are not involved, what is the reason?



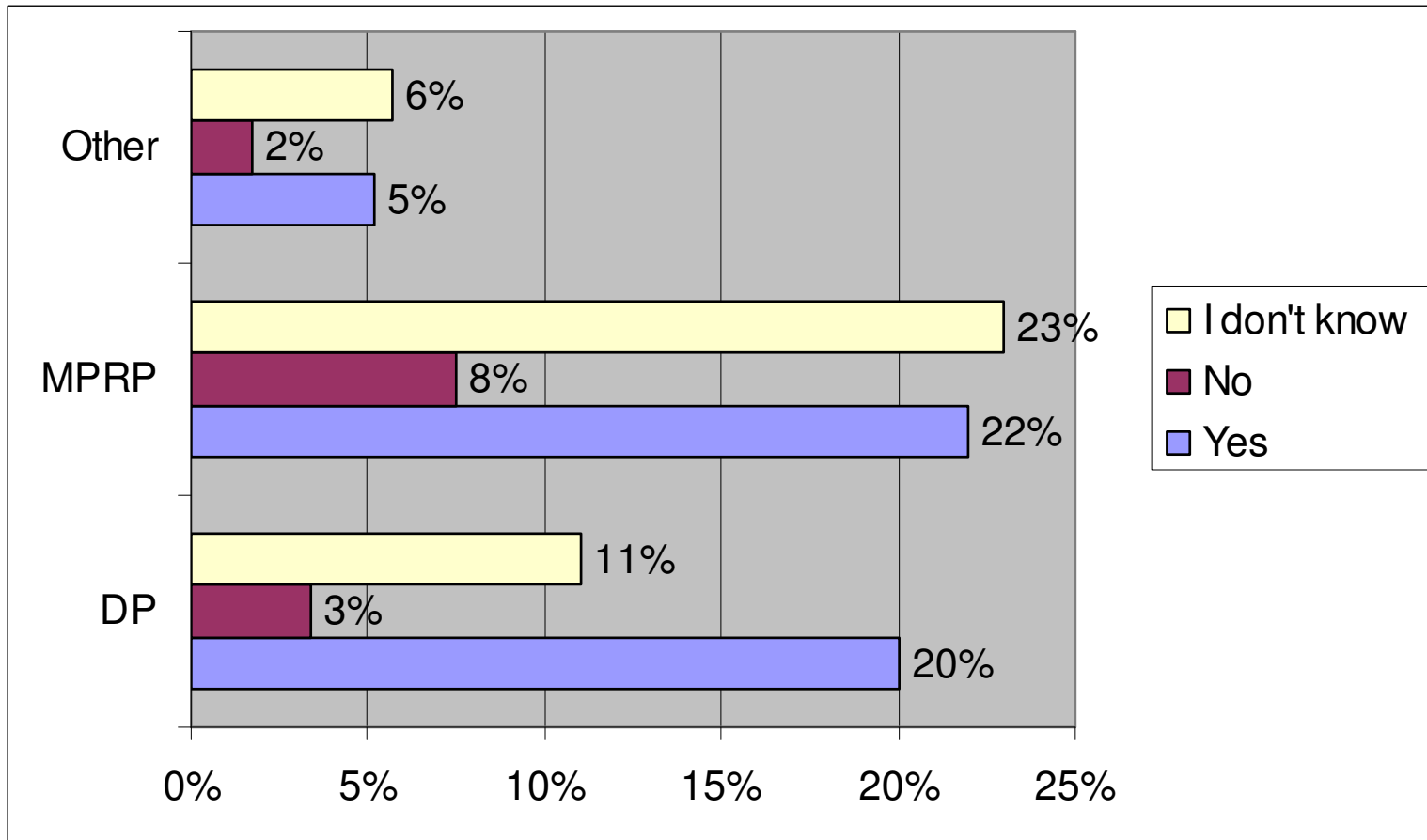
Question-15. Does your party make a financial report for the members of the party?



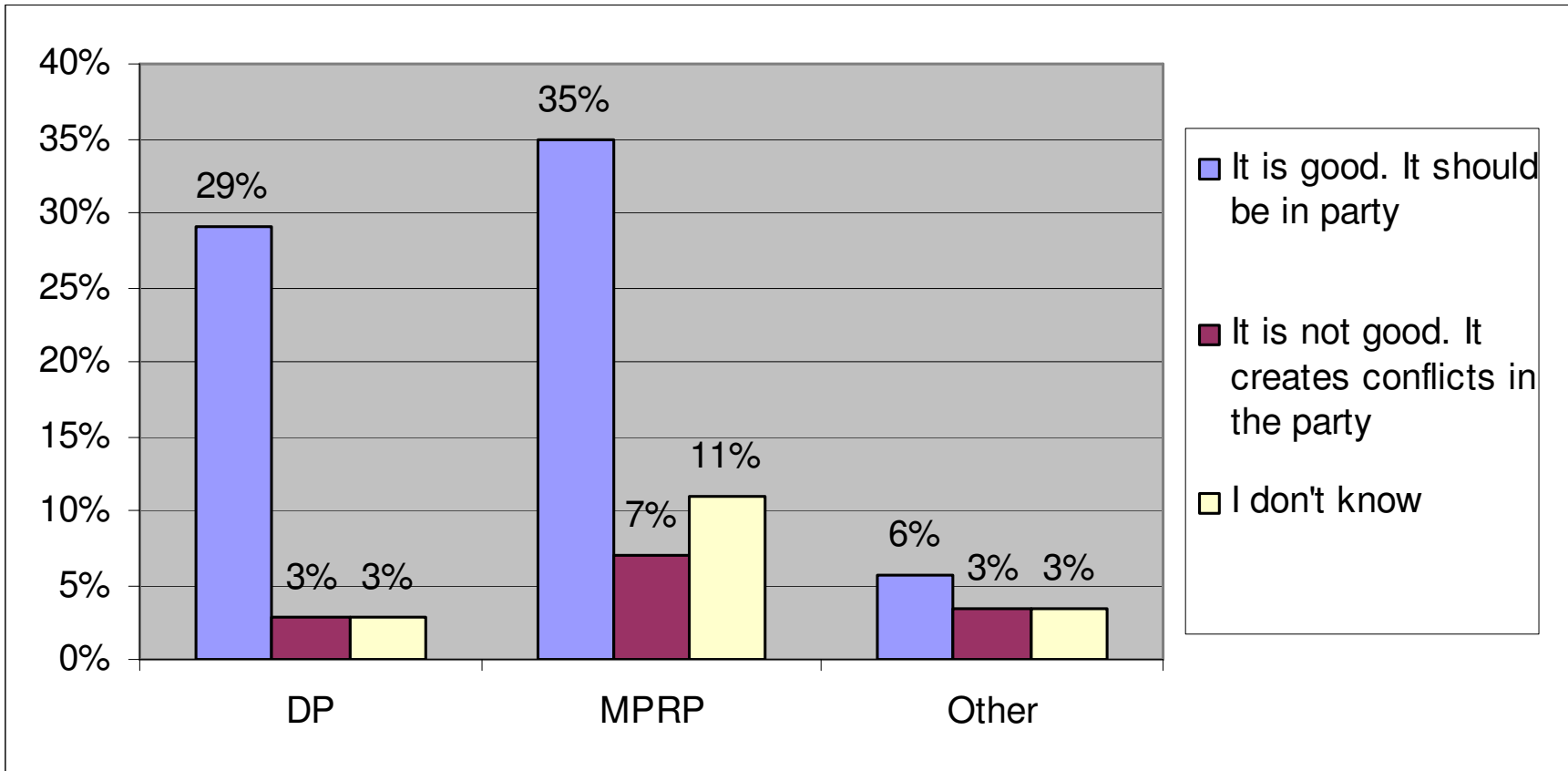
Question-16. Does your party organize any training to improve the political education of its members?



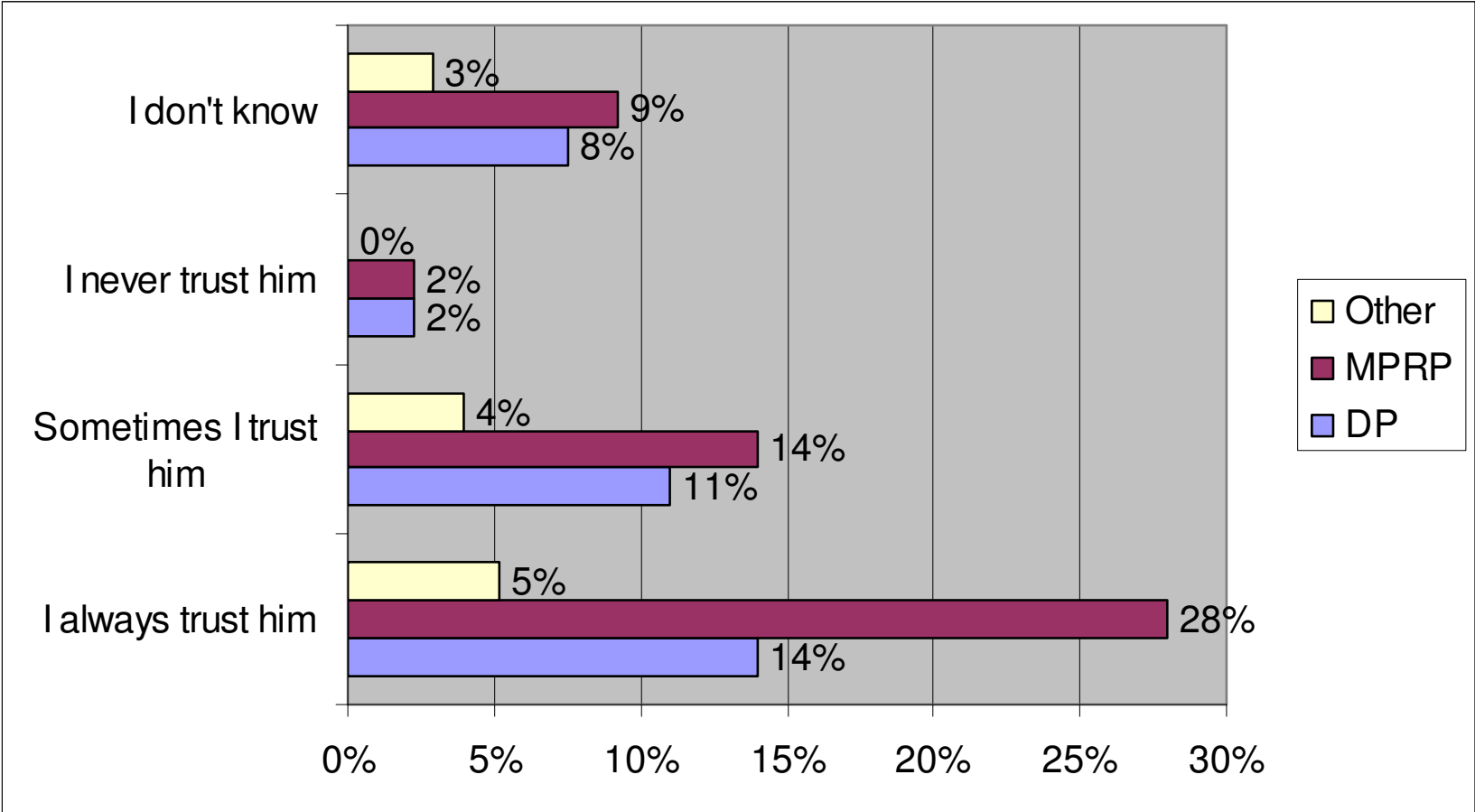

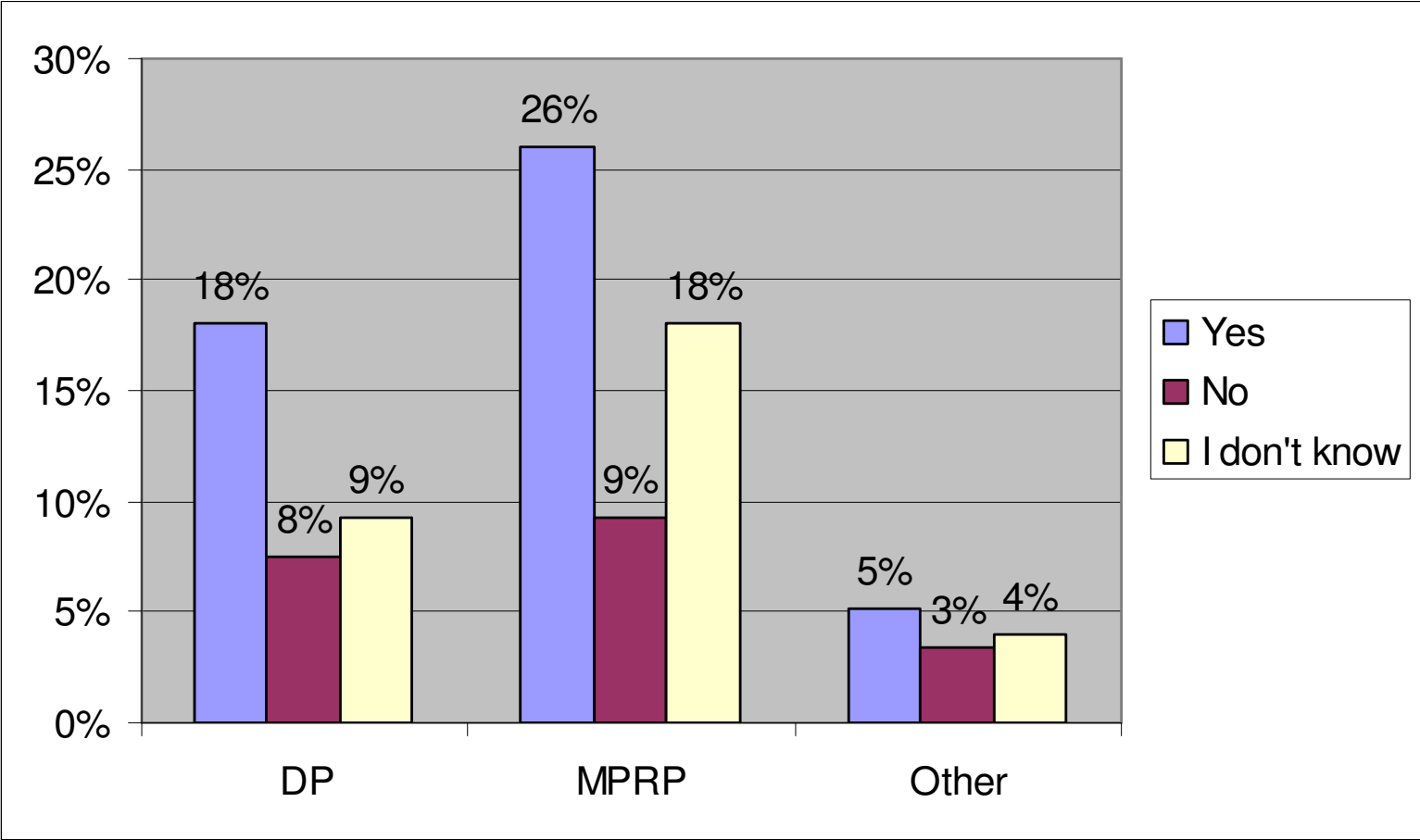
Question-18. How do you value debates in your party?



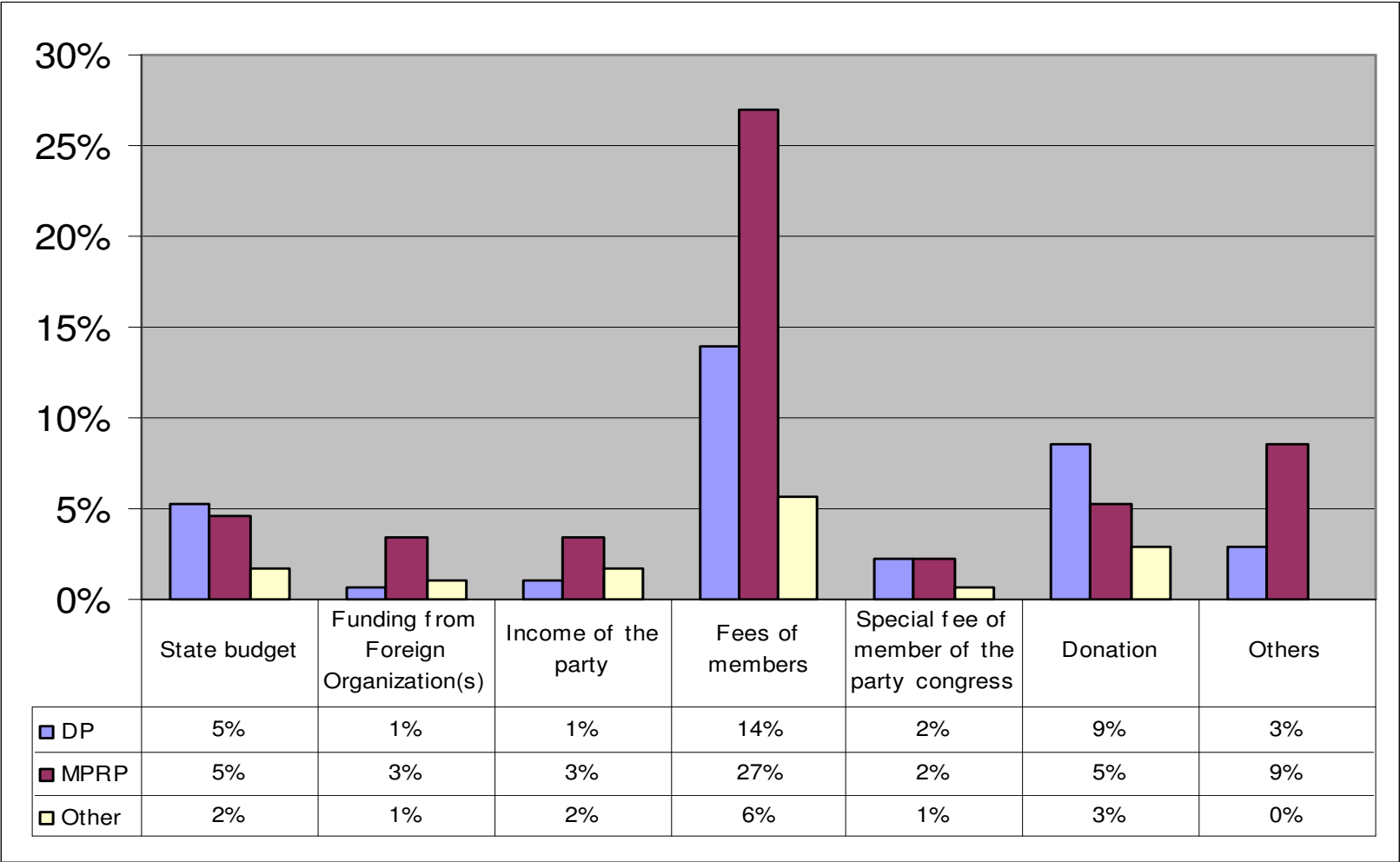

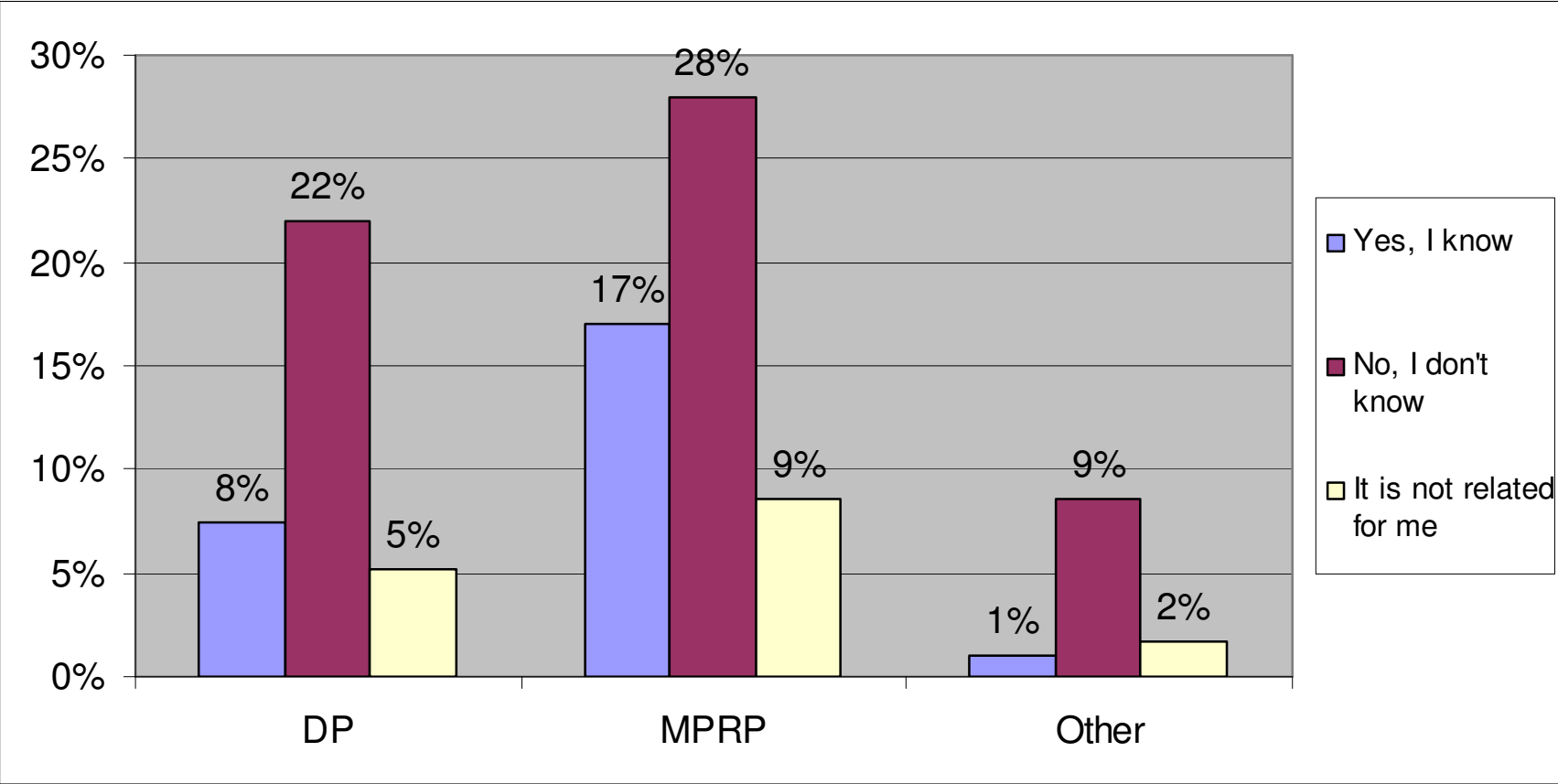

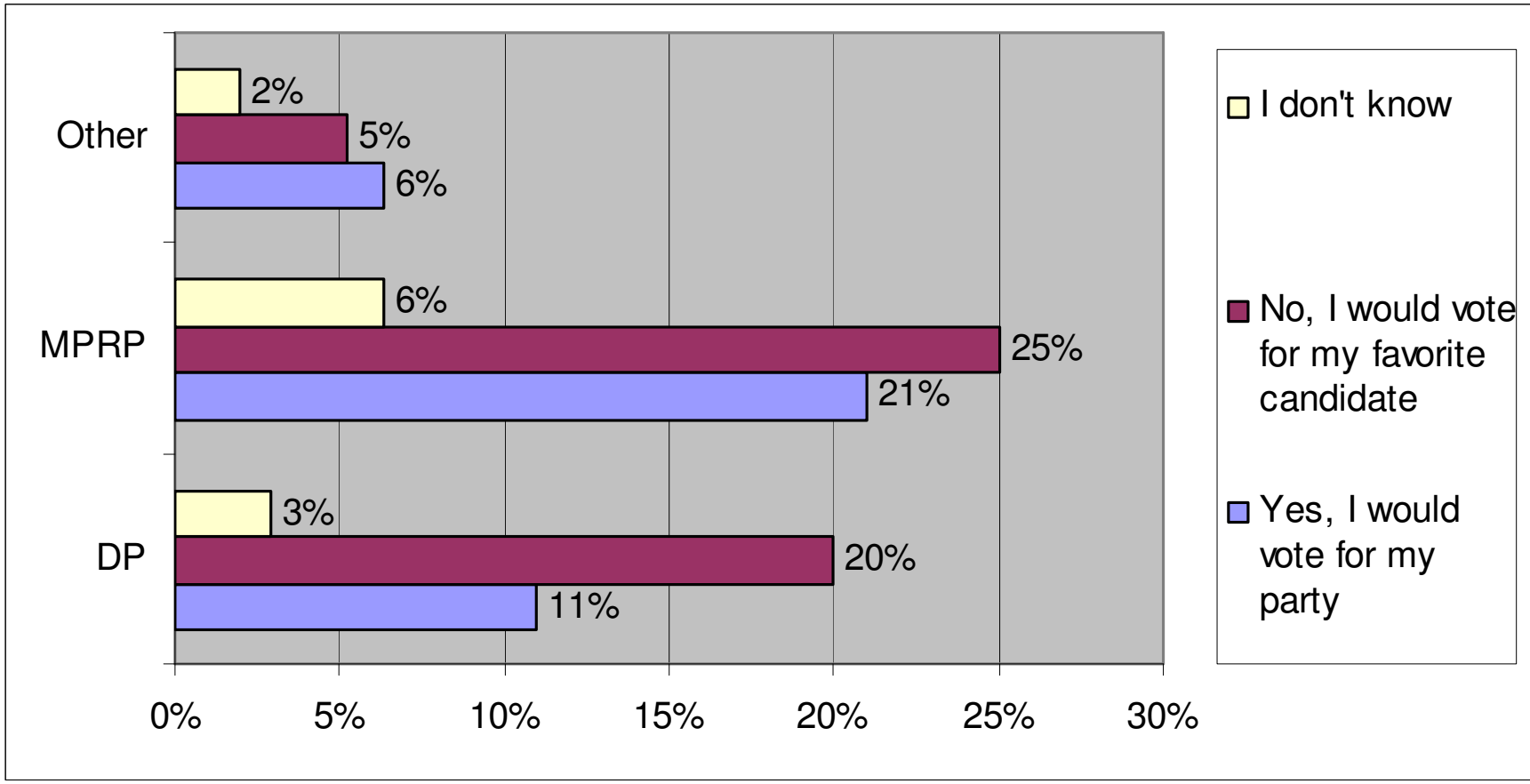
Question-21 What are the sources of funding of your party?



Question-22. If you pay party member's fee, do you know how it is spent?

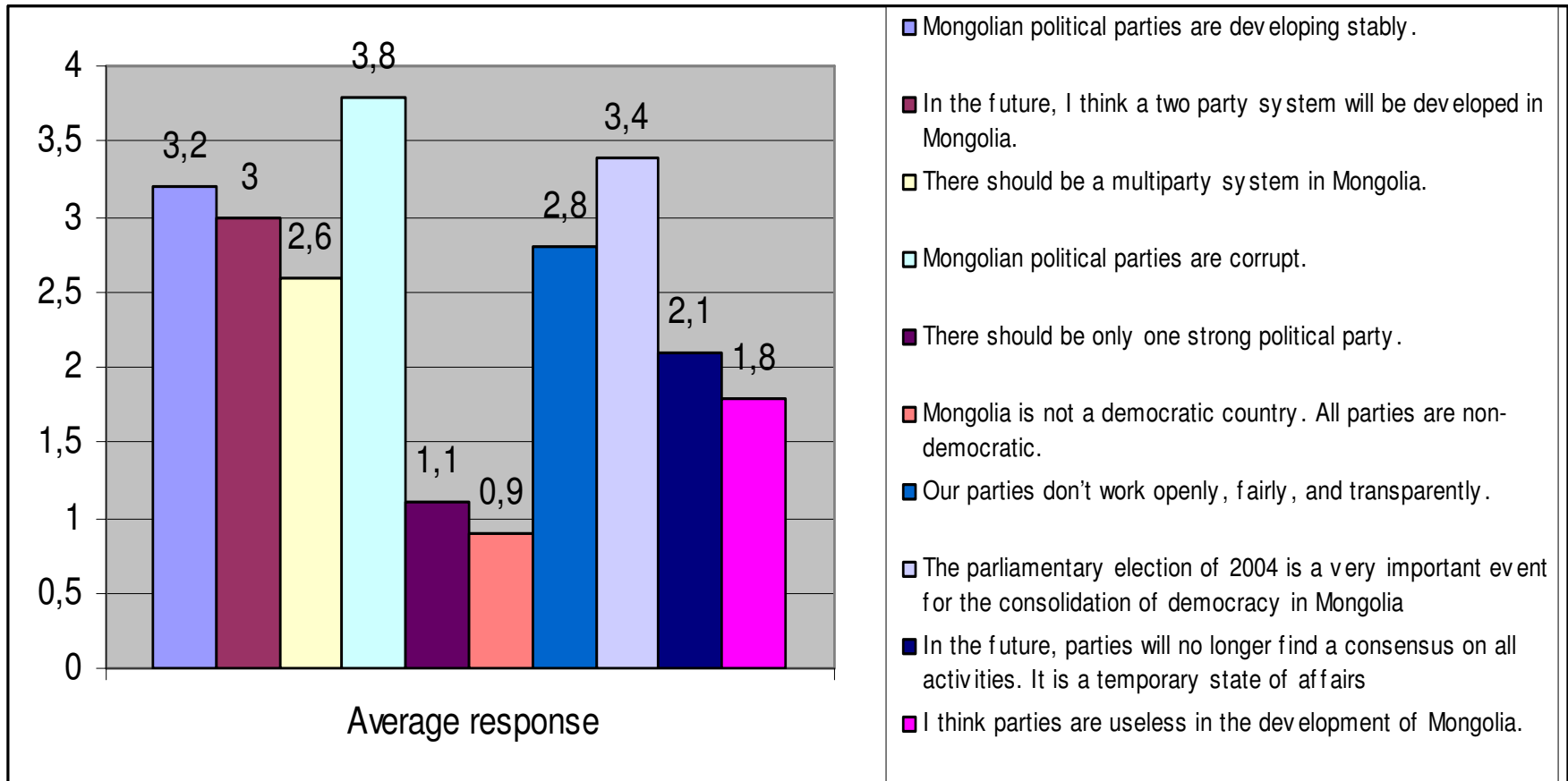


Question-23. If your party didn't nominate the candidate of your choice, , would you still vote for your party?
