THE MAIN REASONS FOR THE LACK OF TRANSPARENCY IN POLITICAL FINANCING:

TRANSPARENCY OF CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED BY POLITICAL PARTIES:

80% - NOT ENOUGH TRANSPARENCY OVER THE WAY OF GIVING AND ACCEPTING CONTRIBUTIONS



72% - TOO EASY FOR CONTRIBUTORS TO HIDE THEIR IDENTITY FROM THE PUBLIC
